Acer palmatum 'Orange Dream' Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; new foliage emerges orange & quickly turn lemon-yellow with orange margins; similar to 'Katsura' but foliage emerges later; foliage slowly turns yellow-green through summer before becoming bright gold in fall; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; upright bushy habit to about 10' tall by 5' wide in 10 years; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; Japanese native (Gilardelli N) Zones 5 - 9</i>			3g	N
